

May 11, 2009

The Chilton County Commission met in a Regular Commission Meeting in the Chilton County Courthouse, in Clanton, Alabama at 9:00 a.m., Monday, May 11, 2009. The following Commissioners were present: Bobby Agee, Allen Caton, Joe Headley, Greg Moore, Tim Mims and Heedy Hayes. A quorum being present, the Chairman opened the meeting for business. Commissioner Heedy Hayes opened the meeting with a prayer, which was then followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Commissioner Heedy Hayes.

WHEREAS, the minutes of the regular Commission Meeting of April 27, 2009 were reviewed and the Chairman asked for additions or corrections, all being correct, the Commissioners affixed their signatures to said minutes in the presence of the Commission and Administrator.

WHEREUPON, Commissioner Headley offered the following resolution which was seconded by Commissioner Hayes:

BE IT RESOLVED that Minooka Park Manager Gerald Arrington may purchase fishing equipment and fish feeders which will be reimbursed thru the CAWACO Grant.

Commissioner Hayes offered the following resolution seconded by Commissioner Caton and carried by a unanimous vote of this Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED to renew the County 2009-2010 building and property insurance with Allstate through Bill Davis Insurance.

Commissioner Headley offered the following resolution seconded by Commissioner Moore and carried by a unanimous vote of this Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Administrator has the authority to have the actuarial study performed as required by GASB Statement 45 concerning other post-employment benefits (OPEB).

Commissioner Caton offered the following resolution seconded by Commissioner Headley and carried by a unanimous vote of this Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED that Ms. Jan Davis with the Chilton County Transit has the authority to file a grant application with the Alabama Department of Transportation and the United States Department of Transportation.

Commissioner Headley offered the following resolution seconded by Commissioner Moore and carried by a unanimous vote of this Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED that Ms. Jan Davis has the authority to furnish information needed to file the grant application and the authority to execute the grant.

Commissioner Caton offered the following resolution seconded by Commissioner Moore and carried by a unanimous vote of this Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED to accept the following resolution presented by Attorney Jackson.  
 WHEREAS, Chilton County, Alabama, acting by and through the Chilton County Commission as the governing body thereof, presently operates the Higgins Ferry Park on Lake Mitchell in accord with a lease agreement allowing it to provide recreational facilities for the citizens of Chilton County, Alabama; and  
 WHEREAS, there is a swimming area for citizens to use which is adjacent to a boat ramp for boaters to use; and  
 WHEREAS, the same is served by parking areas which are immediately adjacent to the boat ramp; and  
 WHEREAS, the parking area is signed and marked as to where vehicles may park and where they may not park; and  
 WHEREAS, vehicles using the swimming facilities have violated the signage and markings for restricted parking to a point where vehicles carrying boat trailers which are properly parked do not have access to either their vehicles or the boat ramp; and  
 WHEREAS, in order to resolved this situation and to provide for the public safety of the citizens using the Higgins Ferry Park for any recreational purpose, the Chilton County Commission wishes to enlist the aid and assistance of the Chilton County Sheriff's Department; and  
 WHEREAS, the Chilton County Sheriff's Department has indicated to the Commission its willingness to assist, so long as said assistance is rendered within the provision of existing Alabama law,  
 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chilton County Commission as the governing body of Chilton County, Alabama, that it does respectfully request the assistance of the Chilton County Sheriff's Department in enforcing the established parking locations at the Higgins Ferry Park on Lake Mitchell, as said places are established by signage and markings painted on the parking lot; and  
 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chilton county Sheriff's Department be requested to enforce said parking limitations in order to protect the public safety of those using the park; and  
 BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Chilton County Sheriff's Department does the same in accord with existing laws, rules and regulations as the same are established by the existing laws of the State of Alabama.  
 ADOPTED AND APPROVED on this the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009.
