

Higgins Ferry Park Rules and Regulations

We would like to maintain a campground that all campers, including the surrounding community, can be proud of. To insure this, your cooperation is necessary. The rules and regulations below are for all campers to adhere to during the period of their stay. Violations of the rules and regulations listed below could result in the revocation of your permit and eviction from the campground without a refund.

The Higgins Ferry Park Rules & Regulations are as follows:

1. We reserve the right to refuse service to any RV based upon its appearance and/or condition.
2. All outdoor items must be kept clean and orderly.
3. Nothing will infringe onto a neighboring site (parked vehicles, trailers, satellite dishes, etc.)
4. Please place all trash in dumpster located in front of Park Ranger's house.
5. Only one camping unit and two vehicles allowed per site.
6. Quiet hours are 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM.
7. Pets must be on a leash at all times and cannot be disturbing to other guests. Owners are required to clean up pet waste.
8. Do not wash clothing, cooking utensils, or dishes in the restrooms.
9. The possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited.
10. No noisy, intoxicated or disorderly persons or loud parties shall be allowed in the campground.
11. Campfires are not permitted unless in self-contained unit. Fires must be attended at all times.
12. Children under 18 are the responsibility of their parents or guardians and need to be with them during quiet hours.
13. Absolutely no use of firearms, explosives, or fireworks in the park.
14. **FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE PARK WITHOUT REFUND.**
